- (1) Meeting was called to order by President, Zenia Warren at 11:30 am.
- (2) The invocation and the pledges to the flags of the United States of America and the State of Texas were led by President, Zenia Warren.
- (3) President, Zenia Warren introduced all elected official and guests. American Flag Pins were given to all members in celebration of Constitution Day, September 17th, 1787.
- (4) Davis Ford made announcement of upcoming event at the Bell County Expo Center, October 14th, 5:00 pm, Lt. Col. Allen West will be the guest speaker. Reservation Information will be sent out as soon as everything is coordinated. President Zenia Warren encouraged all CTRW members to attend in lieu of a formal October meeting.
- (5) President Warren shared highlights from Ronna McDaniel's visit to Williamson County on September 16th, "The Power of 5," challenging every member to talk to 5 voters encouraging them to vote and to pass that on. Getting out the vote could be greatly impacted by doing this. She also encouraged members to Volunteer this month for Red Dialer and block walking.

- (8) Treasurers Report was given by Treasurer Wanita Reeder: Current Balance \$4,932.74.
- (9) Fundraising Report was given by 3rd VP Kathy Ruiz. A financial appeal for donation has been sent out to all members in lieu of Chili Luncheon. Those donations will be reported at the November meeting.
- (10) President Warren explained the process of electing new officers and introduced those members that expressed interest serving on the 2021 Nominating Committee. Kathy Ruiz, Linda Hagler, Janice Mayfield, Katie Francis, Ali Osuch, and Lynda Schumann (Alternate). President Warren asked if there were any other individuals that wanted to serve on this committee. Hearing none, Susan Burchfield made the motion to accept this slate and Karen Fredenberg seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Question was asked and unanimously passed. The Nominating will meet and report their recommendations to be published in the October newsletter.

(11) 1st VP Linda Hagler introduced our guest speaker, Nick Adams, his topic "American Exceptionalism." Nick is an Australian by birth, a Texan by appointment, and an American by choice. He inspired us with this message: "America is the guardian of liberty and custodian of freedom. We must be passionate about preserving our country. I believe in the United States of America because of these four measures of Exceptionalism: America is culturally exceptional, militarily exceptional, economically exceptional, and scientifically exceptional."
